A FLEXIBLE MODEL, GROUNDED IN SUPPORT

USPA is designed for students who need flexibility, and a system that supports their passion and academic journey combined. Students learn asynchronously, connect with teachers one-on-one when they need support, and build an academic calendar that works around real life.

01. SELF-PACED ONLINE LEARNING

Students learn at their own pace through structured slides, video lessons, interactive quizzes, and virtual experiences on the USPA online platform, with integrated messaging, pacing support, and progress visibility for students and families.

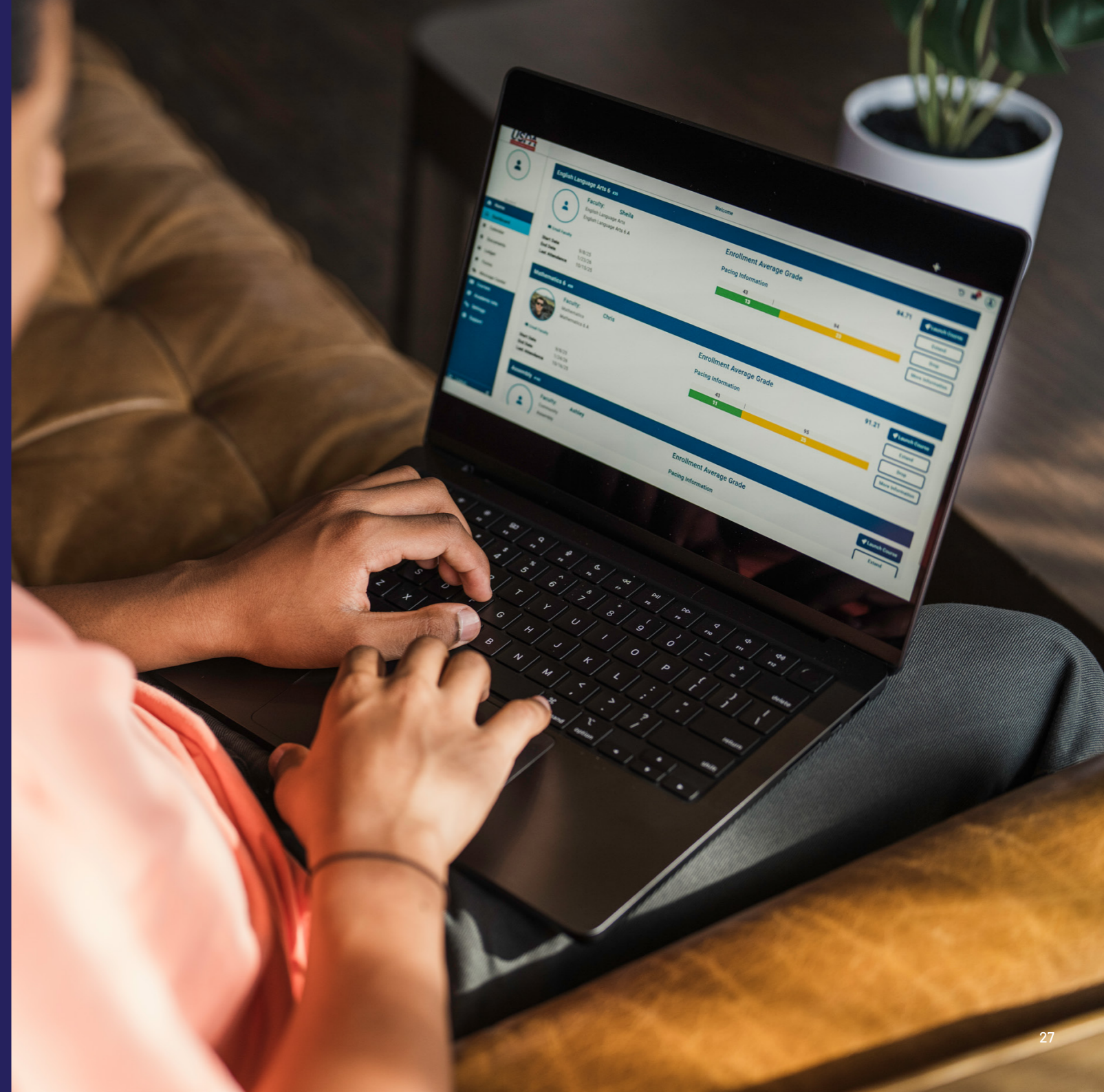
02. FAMILY PARTNERSHIP

USPA's Guided Opportunities for Achievement and Learning (GOAL) program is a neurodiversity-affirming, strengths-based support program for students with specific learning disabilities, ADHD, autism, giftedness, twice-exceptionality, those needing additional support within our learning environment above and beyond our core offer.

GOAL provides individualized support options, including formal accommodation plans, testing accommodations requests on a student's behalf, and 1:1 instruction.

From missed classes to professional soccer.

Malcolm joined USPA as a sophomore with a clear goal: play soccer professionally. His training and travel schedule demanded flexibility, but his parents also needed confidence that he would stay structured and accountable academically.

Before USPA, balancing school and elite soccer was a constant challenge. Missed classes and shifting schedules made it hard to stay on track.

At USPA, Malcolm partnered with a dedicated Learning Coach who helped him plan his coursework around training and travel, maintain academic rigor, and stay focused through recruitment.

“USPA was crucial for me. My teachers and learning coach enabled my studies to be very flexible, yet still rigorous.”

In 2023, Malcolm achieved his goal of signing with the New England Revolution in Major League Soccer as a professional soccer player.

From early podiums to the Olympic Winter Games.

Lara set her sights on the Olympics early. Competing at the highest level meant year-round training, international travel, and being mentally prepared to perform when it mattered most. Like her training, she needed school to work with precision and intention.

“My experience with USPA has been really good in comparison to a regular brick-and-mortar school.”

At USPA, Lara partnered with a dedicated Learning Coach who helped her plan coursework around competition blocks and adjust pacing as training demands changed.

“I have a lot more flexibility, which allows me to train a lot more and it lets me have a much clearer mind when I ski because I don’t have to worry about falling behind.”

That clarity matters when performance is the priority.

“This past winter I had one of my biggest learning curves ever—one of my best winters—and I don’t think that would have been possible if I couldn’t split my school and training the way I do. Since I train so much, I don’t have anything else in my head except what I have to do in my next training run.”

In 2026, Lara represented South Africa competing in Slalom and Giant Slalom at the Milano Cortina Winter Olympic Games.

From Split Focus to NCAA Division I Golfer.

Connor was already an accomplished junior golfer when he joined USPA in 2023, with a clear long-term goal of playing professionally. Training, travel, and tournament play demanded consistency and focus—both on the course and in the classroom.

Before USPA, balancing academics alongside high-level golf was a constant challenge. A busy training schedule and frequent out-of-state competitions made it difficult to stay focused, often pulling Connor’s attention in too many directions.

At USPA, Connor found a structure that allowed his academics to align with the rhythm of his training and competition schedule, giving him the space to focus and improve.

“Attending USPA allows me to balance golf training with school.”

Connor has competed in multiple PGA Junior League National Championships, earned a Titleist sponsorship, and committed in 2025 to play for the University of North Texas as an NCAA Division I golfer.

From National Champion to the Hydro Flask U.S. Snowboard Rookie Team.

Gabby competes in slopestyle and big air, training year-round while traveling for national and international competitions. A former USASA National Champion, she is continuing her rise at the highest levels of the sport.

“Before joining USPA, it was extremely challenging to balance school and competition. Juggling academics while traveling for events was demanding, particularly with limited flexibility in my schedule.”

At USPA, Gabby found an academic environment that understands the realities of high-performance athletics.

“Being a student at USPA while training with the U.S. Ski & Snowboard Team has allowed me to pursue both my academic and athletic dreams without compromise. The flexibility and support from USPA makes it possible for me to travel, train, and compete at the highest level—while staying on track with my education.”

In 2025, Gabby was nominated at just 14 years old to the 2025–26 Hydro Flask U.S. Snowboard Rookie Slopestyle and Big Air Team. She has earned multiple Nor-Am podium finishes, including a National Slopestyle Championship title at Copper Mountain.

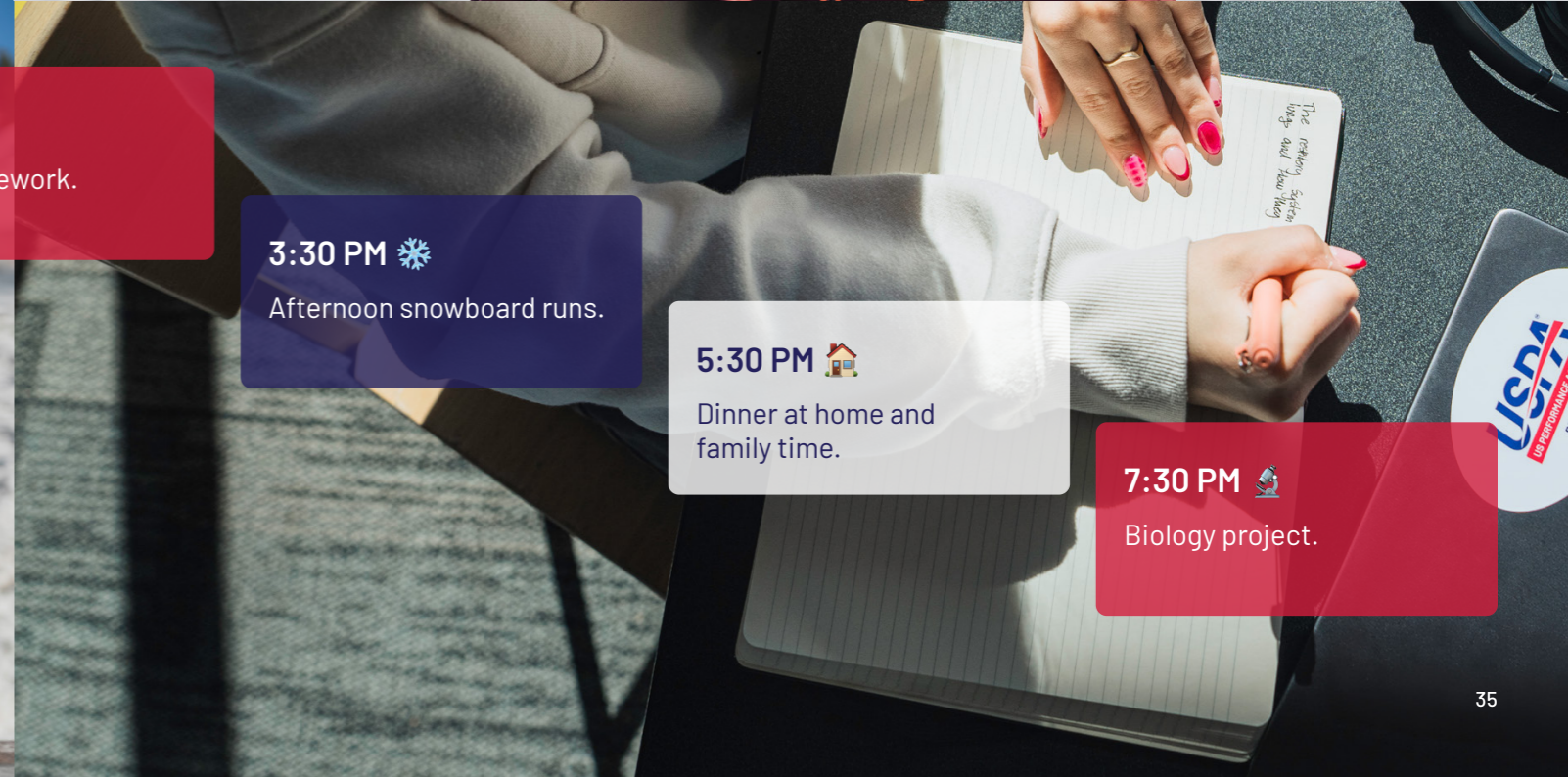
